Cavendish University has reaffirmed its commitment to providing Uganda with high quality, market relevant education through its recent \$1.5 million investment to upgrade its main campus on Ggaba Rd and open a brand new facility in Acacia.

“With this strategic investment, we are continuing to drive our mission to increase our student’s employability through a high quality education in a conducive learning environment,” says university Vice Chancellor Professor Koi. “We anticipate attracting the best students in the region and beyond and providing them with state-of-the-art learning resources. We are also preparing to attract global industry partners who recognize and appreciate the standards we are establishing”

For the first time in its history, the University controls its entire main campus building. Cavendish has capitalized on this by revamping the entire building to provide a facility that will best position it to deliver a modern pedagogical approach focused on employability and quality. Improvements include two brand new IT labs, one for undergraduates and one for graduates. These are complemented by a new high-speed internet network and are part of over 100 new computers that Cavendish has installed across its three Kampala locations since the start of the year. The University has also enlarged and completely refurbished its library and has also equipped it with several new computers to allow students to access the latest in e-learning content.

In addition, Cavendish’s brand new Health Sciences building in Acacia houses an upgraded health sciences lab to support the University’s leading Bachelors and Masters of Public Health and Environmental Health Science programs, which now have their own dedicated facility.
