


# EXIT PROFILE OF THE IDEAL CAVENDISH UNIVERSITY UGANDA GRADUATE

Hon. Dr Chris Baryomunsi is the Minister for ICT and National Guidance in the Cabinet of Uganda, appointed to this position in 2021. Known for his independent thinking, he is not afraid to disagree with his party when it diverts from pro-people issues.

Prior to his current role, Hon. Baryomunsi has held several high-profile positions in Uganda's cabinet, including serving as State Minister of Health for General Duties from 2015 to 2016, and State Minister for Housing from 2016 to 2021.

Hon. Baryomunsi holds Bachelor's Degrees in Medicine and Surgery from Makerere University, and a Postgraduate Diploma and Master of Arts in Demography from the same institution. Additionally, he holds a Postgraduate Diploma in HIV/AIDS Management from the University of Brighton and a PhD in Public Health, majoring in Maternal Health, from Atlantic International University in the USA.

Chris Baryomunsi serves on many prominent boards and committees including; the AIDS Information Centre where he is the Board Chairman, the African Parliamentarians Forum on Population and Development where he is the President, among others.

# HON. LADY JUSTICE MONICA KALYEGIRA MUGENYI

- Justice of the Supreme Court of Uganda
- Ugandan Lawyer

Lady Justice Mugenyi is a Ugandan judge with 30 years' professional experience largely in the public sector. She has first-hand experience in the harmonization of regional jurisprudence within the East African sub-region, as well as substantial experience in the legal aspects of foreign direct investment and private sector development, having led diverse teams in the negotiation and closure of cross-border privatization and divestiture transactions in Uganda.

She is a Justice of the Supreme Court of Uganda following a 4-year stint as a Justice of the Court of Appeal/ Constitutional Court. Prior to her appointment to the Court of Appeal, Justice Mugenyi served as Principal Judge of the East African Court of Justice (2015 - 2020), the only woman to hold that position to date. She previously served as a Judge of the High Court of Uganda; Manager Corporate Services of the Uganda Road Fund; Legal Officer of a World Bank Project on Privatisation & Utility Sector Reform in Uganda, and a Senior State Attorney at the Attorney General's Chambers of Uganda.

Outside the Judiciary, Justice Mugenyi serves as the Chairperson of the EADB (East Africa Development Bank) Staff Appeals Committee, a position she has held since October 2014. She is also a Member of the ICC (International Chamber of Commerce) Commission on Arbitration and ADR since 2021.

Justice Mugenyi is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators of the UK (FCIArb), and holds a Master of Laws Degree in International Trade Law from the University of Essex, UK. She does also hold a Postgraduate Diploma, Legal Practice from the Law Development Centre of Uganda, and a Bachelor of Laws Degree from Makerere University, Uganda.

In August 2022, CUU registered a Staff SACCO aimed at enhancing the financial well-being of university staff under REG NO.P.21941/R25. The SACCO's vision is to become the leading financial cooperative for university employees, providing accessible and sustainable financial services that contribute to socio-economic transformation.

### **Mission and Objectives**

The mission of the SACCO focuses on empowering university staff through innovative financial services and fostering a cooperative spirit, enabling members to thrive in sustainable financial practices. The key objectives include:

- Financial Empowerment
- Education and Capacity Building
- Community Building
- Sustainability and Growth
- Member Engagement and Participation

The SACCO operates on core values of: Integrity, Community, Empowerment, Sustainability, Inclusivity, and Financial Products.

The SACCO has made notable progress since its establishment, with 60% of CUU staff now members who actively engage in governance, independent of university management. As of June 2024, the SACCO has amassed over UGX 100,000,000 in savings and issued more than 50 loans totalling UGX 167,000,000, with 20% of these loans fully repaid on time.

Looking ahead, the SACCO aims to enroll 100% of university staff by the end of the 2024/2025 fiscal year. This will be achieved by expanding its product offerings to include other stakeholders, such as alumni, and securing additional financing to improve members' livelihoods.




















# **2024 HIGHLIGHTS**
